

Burra/Urila Follow-Up Survey — Summary of Results

Survey population	400	
Surveys returned	190	(47.5%)
Q1. Responses were received from residents on 23 of the 27 roads in the area.		
Q2. Respondents residing on their block:	172	(90.5%)
Respondents leasing:	3	(1.6%)
Vacant blocks:	15	(7.9%)
Q3. Respondents supporting continuation of the recycling collection service:	163	(85.8%)
Opposed to continuation:	19	(10.0%)
Q4. 72 (37.9%) respondents offered suggestions relating to the recycling collection service, although almost all were simply comments of support.		
Q5. Respondents in favour of a household waste collection service:	118	(62.1%)
Opposed to household waste collection:	62	(32.6%)
Q6. Preferred collection frequency:		
Weekly	20	
Fortnightly	102	
Q7. 98 (51.6%) respondents offered additional comments.		
The most common comments were:		
• The recycling service is good/great/excellent/fantastic/working well (50)		
• Would welcome household waste collection (8)		
• Go back to the recycling stations (6)		
• Oppose/don't need household waste collection (5)		
• Suggest 140L household waste bin once a fortnight (5)		
(Note: One respondent said they needed a 240L household waste bin collected weekly, and another a 240L recycling bin only once a month)		
• Better arrangements needed at Cargill Park—more bins, address misuse (4)		
• Visual amenity has been improved by removal of recycling stations (4)		
(Note: Two respondents commented that they didn't want the rural character of Burra spoiled by the presence of bins)		
• Don't want additional charges (3)
